

What are YOUR Resolutions?

This time of year, everyone has resolutions. Musicians resolve to spend more time rehearsing and performing, purchase a new instrument, or join a new performance organization. Want to make a resolution you can keep? Keep in mind...

- People make more resolutions to start new habits (84%), than to break an old one (16%).
- Of those who successfully achieved their top resolution, 40% of them did so on the first attempt. The rest made multiple tries, with 17% finally succeeding after more than six attempts.
- 63% of people are still keeping their resolutions after the first two months
- 67% of people actually make 3 or more resolutions

Scholarship Opportunities through IEVFS

The Inland Empire Valley Flute Society is proud to be able to offer an annual Flute Lesson Scholarship to local flute students associated with IEVFS.

The scholarship covers 50% of fees for 6 months of lessons giving a student the means to continue their musical studies in tough economic times. The winner is also given a free student membership and performance opportunity with IEVFS at their Membership Recital.

Applications are accepted through March, final due date to be determined, and require a completed Application Form, Statement of Interest, Musical Resume, and Instructor Recommendation.



